2009 Safety Competencies (based on CanMeds Framework)

The adult critical care medicine resident must :

- demonstrate knowledge and skill in preventing and resolving conflict.
- demonstrate leadership in the continuing education of members of the multi-disciplinary health care team
- contribute to productive communication and cooperation among colleagues in all aspects of education, service, and research, as they impact on the critical care environment, recognizing the multi-disciplinary nature of the specialty
- be familiar with the administrative organization required to operate an Intensive Care Unit within an acute urban or rural hospital
- be knowledgeable regarding unit staffing requirements, skills, education, and organization
- be able to evaluate and cooperatively determine unit equipment requirements.
- be able to manage the clinical, academic, and administrative affairs of. an Intensive Care Unit
